Overview of Position:

This position is located in the consolidated IT department in Kansas City, MO. The Programmer Analyst primarily develops new or modifies existing applications for the District and Bankruptcy Courts and Probation and Pretrial Services.

Qualifications:

The candidate must possess a minimum of 3 years programming knowledge and experience developing web-based applications in JAVA and Java script. Experience developing applications using Object Oriented Programming techniques is required. Candidates should have experience using relational databases, SQL, .NET, PERL, VBA or other scripting macro languages. The ability to capture and apply what is learned is of paramount importance. This candidate must be able to work individually as well as in a team environment.

The ideal candidate will possess a four year degree from an accredited college of university, or combination of education and work experience in a related area or field.
