**ORDER**

Before the Court is individual plaintiff Betty Moss's Stipulation of Dismissal Pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(a)(1)(A)(ii) (Doc. No. 226). Notably, the text of this document indicates that plaintiff "respectfully moves to dismiss the above-captioned action with prejudice," pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(a)(2). As this stipulation/motion is not signed by counsel for defendant, the Court will treat this document as a motion to dismiss pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(a)(2). As defendant consents to dismissal with prejudice, plaintiff's motion (Doc. No. 226) is **GRANTED**, and plaintiff Moss's claims are **DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE**.
