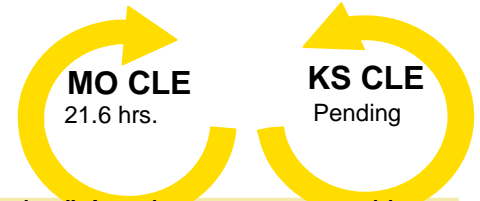

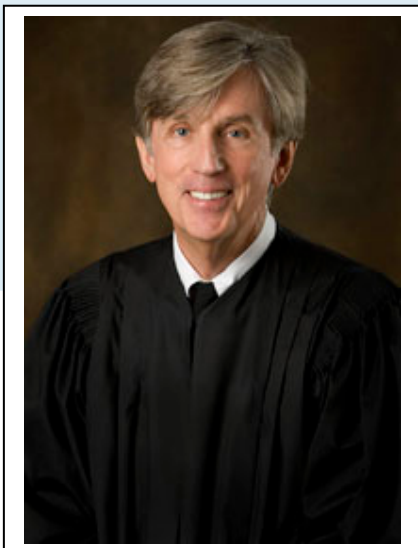

Luncheon lectures presented by Hon. Robert E. Larsen, United States Magistrate Judge, Western District of Missouri from 1991 until his retirement from the court on May 31, 2017. He began his career in January of 1974 as a staff attorney for the Criminal Division of the United States Department of Justice. In September of 1976, he became an Assistant U.S. Attorney in the U.S. Attorney's Office. He worked in this office in various capacities until his 1991 judicial appointment. In December of 1981, he became the Chief of the Criminal Division. From 1983 to 1988, he served as the Attorney-in-Charge of the Organized Crime Drug Enforcement Task Force. He then worked as the First Assistant U.S. Attorney until June of 1990, when he became Senior Litigation Counsel. Judge Larsen received his B.A. degree from Rockhurst College in 1969 and his [J.D.](#) from the University of Missouri at Kansas City School of Law in 1973

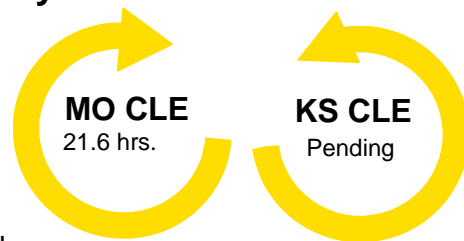
