

Amendment to Local Rule 1007-1D Requiring Electronic Filing of the Declaration Re: Electronic Filing

The Western District of Missouri Bankruptcy Court adopted a change to the Local Rule 1007-1D on December 3, 2010, effective January 1, 2011.

The change is as follows:

The Declaration Re: Electronic Filing – This document which is currently sent to the court and filed in paper must be filed electronically beginning with cases filed **January 1, 2011 or after.**

A separate ECF entry is required; the entry should be made on the same day the petition is filed. The document must continue to contain the full social security number. The document is maintained as a private entry and is not available to the public.

To file the Document electronically, select “Other” from the list of Bankruptcy Events



Input the case number. Then from the list of available events search for “Declaration RE: Electronic Filing”. Select this event.

Once the event is selected you will be prompted to browse and select your PDF Document (The Declaration of Electronic Filing with the full social security number of the Debtor). Attach your PDF Document as normal.
