This court promulgated 2021 Amended General Order No. 4 to implement the substantive and procedural changes mandated by the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES Act), which was enacted March 27, 2020, and added Section 1329(d) to the Bankruptcy Code for the one-year period March 27, 2020, to March 26, 2021, and then extended to March 26, 2022, by the COVID-19 Bankruptcy Relief Extension Act of 2021.

As the provisions of Section 1329(d) were not extended past March 26, 2022, Amended General Order No. 4 is hereby vacated.
