Administrative Order

The Judicial Conference of the United States sets the maximum page rate that may be charged for Court transcripts. The District Court is authorized to adopt a schedule of transcript fees consistent with the rates.

The Court orders that the Maximum Per Page Transcript Rates for all categories of transcript, appended to this Order is adopted by the United States District Court for the Western District of Missouri, and shall apply to all transcripts ordered effective October 1, 2023.

Court Reporter Transcript Rate Schedule (effective 10/1/23)

Original and Copy Rates are Prescribed by the Judicial Conference of the United States

	Original	First Copy to Each Party	Each Add'l Copy to the Same Party
30-Day Transcript (Ordinary) A transcript to be delivered within thirty (30) calendar days after receipt of an order.	\$4.00	\$1.00	\$.70
14-Day Transcript A transcript to be delivered within fourteen (14) calendar days after receipt of an order.	\$4.70	\$1.00	\$.70
7-Day Transcript (Expedited) A transcript to be delivered within seven (7) calendar days after receipt of an order.	\$5.35	\$1.00	\$.70
3-Day Transcript A transcript to be delivered within three (3) calendar days after receipt of an order.	\$6.00	\$1.20	\$.85
Next-Day Transcript (Daily) A transcript to be delivered on the calendar day following receipt of the order (regardless of whether that calendar day is a weekend or holiday), prior to the normal opening hour of the clerk's office.	\$6.70	\$1.35	\$1.00
2-Hour Transcript (Hourly) A transcript of proceedings to be delivered within two (2) hours from receipt of the order.	\$8.00	\$1.35	\$1.00
Realtime Transcript A draft unedited transcript produced by a certified realtime reporter as a byproduct of realtime to be delivered electronically during proceedings or immediately following receipt of the order.	One feed, ¹ \$3.40 per page; two-to-four feeds, \$2.35 per page; five or more feeds, \$1.65 per page.		

¹ A realtime "feed" is the electronic data flow from the court reporter to the computer of each person or party ordering and receiving the realtime transcription in the courtroom.
