SECTION 1328(I)

- A new form for a Motion for Entry of Chapter 13 Discharge under 1328(i) is now on the court's website.
- Use the ECF event - **Bankruptcy – Motions & Related Filings – Motions/Applications/Requests – Chapter 13 Discharge Under 1328(i)**.
- While there is a 21-day notice period, all motions filed under this new section will be set for hearing by the court even if no response is filed.
- This form and event will be removed from public access after the provision sunsets on December 27, 2021.
