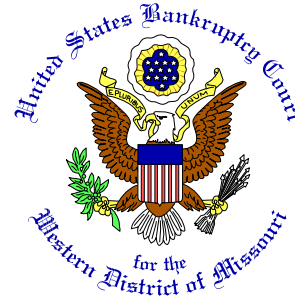

GENERAL ORDER AMENDING LOCAL RULE 4008-1

For good cause shown, and pending revision to this Court's local rules, it is hereby ORDERED that Local Rule 4008-1. is amended to read:

Rule 4008-1. Reaffirmation Agreements is amended to read:

A. Filing of Reaffirmation Agreement. Form. A reaffirmation agreement pursuant to § 524(c) shall be filed no later than 60 days after the first date set for the meeting of creditors under § 341(a) of the Code. A party seeking to enlarge this time shall file a motion to extend time. Agreements to reaffirm debt pursuant to § 524(c) shall be executed on Director's Procedural Form B240 promulgated by the Administrative Office of the United States Courts and available on the Court's website.

B. Statement in Support of Reaffirmation Agreement. In compliance with Fed. R. Bankr. P. 4008, the debtor's statement required under § 524(k)(6)(A) (Part D of the reaffirmation agreement) shall be accompanied by a statement of the total must include information reflecting the income and expenses ~~shown~~ stated on Schedules I and J. ~~of the Schedules of Assets and Liabilities and any discrepancies~~ If there is a difference between the income and expense amounts figures shown on Part D and Schedules I and J ~~must be explained~~ stated on those schedules and the statement required under § 524(k)(6)(A), the statement required by this subsection shall include an explanation of the difference.

B.C. Certification. In addition to the reaffirmation agreement, debtor's counsel shall file the Certification of Debtor's Attorney Regarding Reaffirmation Agreement that substantially conforms to the Local Form (See Local Form, MOW 4008-1.1).

C.D. Processing and Judicial Review of Reaffirmation Agreements. The procedures described below relate to review of reaffirmation agreements for potential undue hardship under § 524(m).
