## 2010 STANDING ORDER NUMBER 1 GRANTING AN EXTENSION TO THE DEBTOR IN AN INVOLUNTARY BANKRUPTCY CASE TO FILE THE LIST OF CREDITORS

Under the provisions of Fed. R. Bankr. P. 1007(a)(2), as amended effective December 1, 2010, involuntary debtors are given seven days after entry of the order for relief to file the list containing the name and address of each entity included or to be included on Schedules D, E, F, G. and H.

These provisions would require the debtor to submit the list in advance of the date by which their schedules must be submitted which is fourteen days after entry of the order for relief.

It is therefore

ORDERED that all involuntary debtors are hereby granted an extension of time to file the list of creditors to fourteen days after the entry of the order for relief.
