ORDER OF CLARIFICATION

On December 22, 2021, the Court entered an Order Setting Initial Pretrial Conference and General Order on Practice and Procedure. (Doc. #4) ("Initial Pretrial Order"). This Initial Pretrial Order included the following:

5. Attorneys are advised to review the docket to ensure their appearances have been properly entered. If an attorney is not listed on the docket, he or she should file a notice of appearance in MDL No. 3019. *Motions to appear pro hac vice are not required.* Any attorney not listed on the docket sheet and not registered to use the electronic filing system will not receive notice from the Clerk's Office of orders and other documents by the Court.

(Doc. #4 at 5).

The Court now clarifies that "motions to appear pro hac vice are not required" pertains only to counsel who were counsel of record in one of the member cases before consolidation and transfer by the JPML. For counsel not having previously entered an appearance in one of the member cases before transfer to this Court, now seeking to enter an appearance in this MDL, "new" counsel must satisfy requirements for admission to practice in the U.S. District Court for the Western District of Missouri or file a motion for pro hac vice admission, consistent with required Clerk's Office procedures.
