ORDERED the parties’ Consent Motion to Enlarge Page Limits (Doc. #53) is GRANTED. Defendants are granted leave to exceed by 15 pages the limit set forth in L.R. 7.0 for the suggestions in support of their Motion to Compel Arbitration. The argument section of Defendants’ supporting suggestions shall not exceed 30 pages. Likewise, Plaintiffs are granted leave to exceed by 15 pages the limit set forth in L.R. 7.0 for the suggestions in opposition to Defendants’ Motion to Compel Arbitration. The argument section of Plaintiffs’ opposition suggestions shall not exceed 30 pages. It is further

ORDERED this matter is set for **status conference by telephone on May 17, 2024 at 11:00 a.m. CDT.** The Courtroom Deputy shall arrange participation in the conference call. It is further

ORDERED, unless otherwise specified, it is the Court’s intent to conduct status conferences in this matter by telephone. If the parties believe a disputed issue would be best addressed through in-court appearances, the parties should indicate that to the Courtroom Deputy by email as soon as practicable before the next scheduled conference and/or in the joint proposed agenda. It is further

ORDERED the Clerk of the Court is directed to send a copy of this Order to the Clerk of the Judicial Panel on Multidistrict Litigation.
